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KLIx CAM INSTRUCTIONS

1  LINE UP CAM LOCK TURN CLOCKWISE.	2  INSERT THE CAM WITH THE ARROW POINTING TOWARDS THE HOLE IN THE EDGE.	3  INSERT THE CAM LOCK INTO KLIx CAM. TURN KLIx CAM TO LOCK.
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IMPORTANT NOTE :

- Place all wooden parts on a clean, smooth surface to prevent the parts from being scratched.
- Check that you have all parts and hardware.
- Remove all wrapping materials, including staples & packing straps before you start to assemble.
- Do not tighten any screws or bolts until the unit is completely assembled.
- Keep all hardware parts out of reach of children.
